



# TANF Fertility-Related Rules

- TANF can fund "prepregnancy" family planning
- Family caps allowed
- Bonuses to states that most decrease "Illegitimacy Ratio"
  \* \$20 million/yr. to 5 states

# TANF Teenager-Related Rules

- ► Live in adult-supervised setting
- ▶ Be in school or training program
- ▶ \$50 million/yr. for abstinence-only education
- States can require non-custodial teen parents to "fulfill community work obligations"
