



# Percent had sex in past year, by age and sex





 $1990 \to 38.4$ 

 $1995 \to 40.4$ 

#### National Survey of Family Growth, CDC:

% of females aged 15-19 who ever had sex:

 $1988 \rightarrow 53$ 

 $1990 \rightarrow 55$ 

 $1995 \rightarrow 50$
